The European commodity market: the benefit of absolute advantage

Northern commodities: fur, fish, grain, tar, timber, iron, copper, hemp, flax, woollen cloth, linnen

American commodities:
Silver, sugar, tobacco.

Asian commodities:
pepper, spices, tea, silk
and cotton fabrics.



Southern commodities: salt, wine, fruit, olive oil, silk, wool





Iberian expansion, 1500











The Flemish hub, 1550








The English commercial system: mercantilistic bilateral trade

• Government policy: mercantilism







